Board of Selectmen Meeting: June 29, 2020

Approve minutes: BOS meetings June 1 and 9, 2020: Motion FE/JJ to approve as corrected, passed.

Sign bill manifest: Motion JJ/FE to approve, passed.

Sign payroll manifest: Motion JJ/FE to approve, passed.

Public Input:

1. Greg Bascom returned concerning sap lines in culverts. RD expressed reluctance to create a precedent which could present future liability to the Town. There was discussion about setting a 4' culvert size criteria supported by EK. Need to check with Regional Planning for other towns' criteria if any and revisit next meeting.
2. FMRSD unable to attend.

Highway Department Report:

1. Beryl Mountain paving status: In progress including aprons.
2. Work update/plan: Beaver problem continues; Motion RD/FE to hire a trapper, passed. Bascom Farm second manure spill on Parson's Road; RD will call. Grading gravel roads in progress.

Transfer Station: Burn ban lifted; Glass presort table installed; Motion RD/FE to sign updated NRRA glass contract acknowledging presort, passed.

Action items:

1. Building permits: Dimarzio services waiver signed for recording. Temporary storage follow up letter: Motion FE/JJ to sign, passed.
2. Intents: Miller To Cut, Vinton Road with Road Improvement application, Motion JJ/FE to sign both, passed.
3. Junkyard license, Relihan: The Board reviewed application requirements with SR. It was noted the Planning Board will hold a public hearing for the Nonresidential Site Plan Review and following that ZBA will need to approve the site. It was also noted that permission from the deed holder is needed and a lockable gate is required. The storage container will need to be moved inside the fenced area.
4. Primex: Annual coverage: Approved by consensus.
5. Ballfield: A locked vehicle gate has been installed to prevent damage to field. Key is available from Town office.
6. Correspondence: ATV's in East Acworth. It was noted Fish and Game are the enforcing authority.
7. Junkyard complaint: A complaint against Steve Morris was reviewed. JJ viewed site and reported unregistered vehicles in excess of the criteria. RD will view.

Other items:

2. Next meeting: July 20.
